58. Dennis Tate/Andrew Wilson. 2.0 Vauxhall Astra GSi (Agrochem; Cyanimide Chemicals). They bent a strut and wishbone on the opening stage. Without a spare wishbone, they had to try and straighten the original one but with only limited success, as it snapped altogether on the way to the final stage. **DNF.**

59. Daniel Beckham/Leigh Gray. 1.6 Vauxhall Nova GSi (Apple Developments). Clutch slip was followed by the disappearance of first and second gears. Unable to cure the problem, they went home. **DNF.**

60. Dave Hull/Pamela Ludgate. 1.9 Peugeot 309 GTI (Chapman Stevens Insurance Brokers; PB Motorsport; Deb; PEC Tyres; GMT Garages). After getting away with numerous moments on the first four stages, their luck ran out on the fifth when an engine mounting broke causing the unit to drop and a driveshaft to pull out. **DNF.**

61. John Pritchard/Ian Marshall. 1.3 Skoda Favorit. **Overall 35th; Class 1st.**

62. Dave Jennings/Garrett O'Connor. 1.3 Skoda Favorit (Avenue Service Station; APS Video Filming). A roll on SS3 put them out of the event but worse was to come as, having been rescued, they were driving out of the stage when the car caught fire. Were it not for the swift action of Peak Rally Rescue, the car would definitely be history. **DNF.**

63. Arron Cruickshank/Christine Paul. 1.3 Skoda Favorit (First Base Timber; W R Cruickshank; Andersons Agricultural Spares; Lex Transfleet; Deans of Dumfries). Having to change a puncture on SS3 cost seven minutes. Attempts to make up for lost time saw the car land in a ditch on the final stage but it survived to make the finish. **Overall 43rd; Class 6th.**

65. Peter Cuthbert/Chris Peel. 1.3 Skoda Favorit (Barmoor Garage, Ryton). An off at the end of SS1 cost nine minutes but they managed to continue, only to hit someone else's exhaust system lying in the middle of SS3. The impact buckled a front wheel which then allowed the nuts to come loose. By the time they arrived at service, there was only one still attached to the car. **Overall 51st; Class 11th.**

66. Carl Stevens/Wayne Rodgers. 1.3 Skoda Favorit (Stevens & Ross; East Midlands Communications; Jetyres). A poor tyre choice for the opening stage left them struggling to keep up with Trophy leader, Pritchard. **Overall 38th; Class 2nd.**

67. Charles Armstrong/Richard Bevan. 2.0 Vauxhall Astra GTE. **DNF.**

68. Richard Perry/Clive Townend. 1.6 Peugeot 205 GTI. **Overall 37th; Class 2nd.**

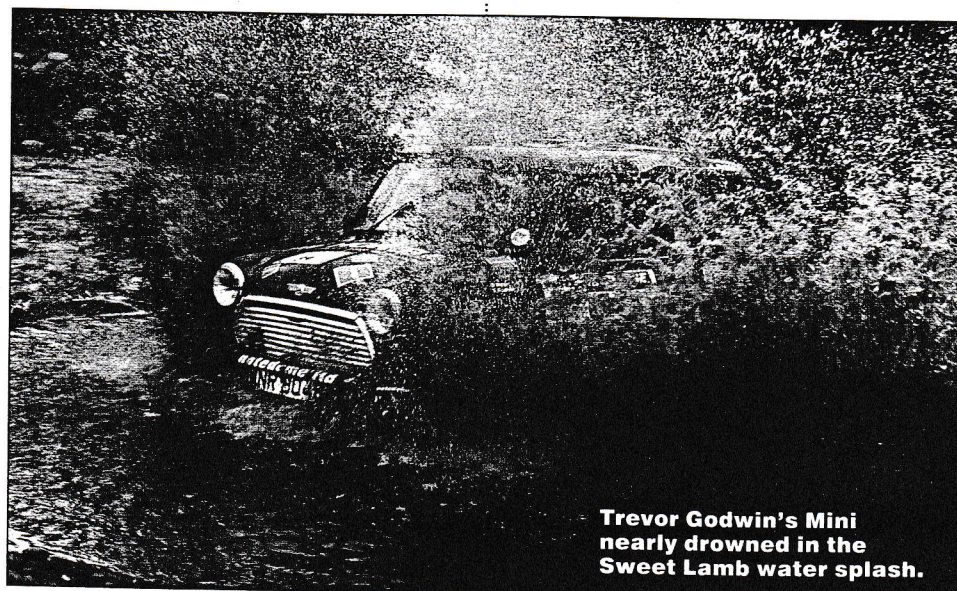
670. Mike Cawthra/Paul Green. 1.3 Skoda Favorit. **Overall 40th; Class 3rd.**

71. Pete Goodwin/Robin Hernaman. 1.3 Skoda Favorit (T A Porter & Sons; Prince Avenue Service Station). The loss of five minutes on SS2 while changing a puncture ruined any chance of a good result. **Overall 46th; Class 7th.**

72. Pete Boddy/Eddie Beilby. 1.3 Skoda Favorit (Rainworth Motors; Atom Computers). A big off on SS2 left the car upside-down and out of view of the passing traffic. Two 4x4s were required to lift it out of the trees but, needless to say, it was too late to carry on. **DNF.**

73. Nick Skelton/Andy Turnbull. 1.3 Skoda Favorit. A double roll on SS1 put them out. **DNF.**

74. Tim Green/Andy Poppleton. 1.3 Skoda Favorit (Jewsons of Oxford). First it was third gear, then all the others started to
